Diego San Millán is a diagnostic and interventional neuroradiologist. He was born in Madrid Spain in 1971. He is currently head of the Neuroradiology unit at the Valais Hospital in Sion. He obtained his MD from Geneva University, where he later worked in the Morphology Department. He completed his residency in radiology and his training in diagnostic neuroradiology at the Radiology department of Geneva University Hospital.
