

Prof. Alejandro (Alex) Spiotta completed his undergraduate studies at the University of Pennsylvania and then obtained his medical degree from the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. He completed his Neurosurgery residency training at Cleveland Clinic, as well as a two-year fellowship in Neuroendovascular Surgery. He was then recruited to the Medical University of South Carolina.

Alex Spiotta is currently the Director of the Neuroendovascular Surgery Division as well as the Program Director of the Neurosurgery Residency program. He has authored greater than 160 peer reviewed publications, served as the editor for three textbooks, and is an editor and reviewer for three peer review journals. He has served as Principal Investigator for three large national clinical trials. His areas of expertise include aneurysm treatment and ischemic stroke disease.
